Notes.—Never use Paragraph 4 or preceding page except when it is intended to sit the water to be appropriated; in such case the volume of water to be stored should be given in acre feet in that space. The time during which the water is to be stored in the reservoir should be stated in Paragraph 6, and the time during which it is to be released and used should be set forth in Paragraph 5. The lands to be inundated by the reservoir must be described in the space below the notes as nearly as may be and by government subdivisions if upon surveyed land. The area of the reservoir when at full stage should be given in acres in the same space. If the reservoir is located on a natural stream bed and the water is to be released from the reservoir into the natural channel it should be so stated in Paragraph 9. The data given in Paragraphs 10 to 20 inclusive, should be described in the space below the note except when the water is taken from the supplying source and should be described in Paragraph 9 and the center of the impounding dam of such work. Paragraphs 10 to 20 inclusive, should describe the diverting works. In case the application is made for the water from a number of springs, the point where the water is collected should be described as the point of diversion and the works below it described as the diverting works; those above it should be described as the collecting works in the space below. Each spring really a spring arm, the point of diversion is the point where the water will be collected.

The following additional facts are set forth in order to define more clearly the full purpose of the proposed appropriation:

The water hereby appropriated is to be stored in the Echo Reservoir by means of a dam upon the material of Hiller Pines, the center of the surrounding claim of which is to be located at the point specified in paragraph 9. The water is to be released and allowed to flow down the natural channel of said Hiller Pines from which it is to be withdrawn and the various points specified below.

And used as a supply for irrigation to irrigate all the lands susceptible of irrigation among the various existing claims as specified, and lands under new concessions as specified in paragraph 21.
