We were told that our water was being taken away because we do not have enough water. We were also told that our water was being taken away because we had not been using enough of it. Neither of these makes much sense because they contradict each other. Discussing this issue with my neighbor a comment was made of if I do not use my car for five years that I plan on driving later will it get taken away? I feel that you are trying to do this with our water. I am very sure we will use it later. I disagree in our water getting taken away. I also feel that who ever is in control of the water will also control the land. The people in the Beryl/Enterprise area own their own land so they should control their own water.

I would appreciate it if this letter could be made public record or published for the public to read.
It would be very appreciated if our water issue could be resolved in a proper manner.
