HOW TO USE THIS FORM:

This Extension of Time Request must be filed with the State Engineer within the 90-day period to file a statement of claim (Utah Code § 73-4-10). Extension Requests filed after the 90-day period to file a claim will not be recognized by the State Engineer. Extension Requests may be filed by mail, by email to waterrights\_adjudication@utah.gov, or in person at the Division of Water Rights. Upon filing, the claimant will be granted one 30-day extension within which to file a statement of claim in the respective adjudication division or subdivision. Under Utah law, unless you file a written statement of water user's claim within 90 days of receiving notice, your water rights shall be considered abandoned (Utah Code § 73-4-9). Signing and returning this form will not update ownership with the Division of Water Rights. If title to a water right needs to be updated, you must prepare and file a separate Report of Water Right Conveyance with the State Engineer.
