Item No. 1 is an application completed by the Central Utah Water Conservancy District to appropriate 6.55 second-feet of water from the Duchesne River for use by the Rocky Point Ditch Company. This application was made along with 24 other filings seeking quantities less than 5 c.f.s. in an effort to cover existing uses of water along the Duchesne River system not covered by established water rights.

Item No. 2 is an application prepared by the Uintah Power and Light Co. to cover a proposed enlargement of its hydro-electric power plant on the Uintah River.

Applications indicated as items 3 and 4 were deposited by the Dry Gulch Irrigation Company to establish rights to storage of water in existing reservoirs constructed by the company on tributaries of the Uintah River.

Item No. 5, an application of the U. S. B. R., covers construction of the proposed Starvation Reservoir on the Strawberry River with a feeder canal from the Duchesne River.

Item 6 in the name of the U. S. B. R. covers the authorized Bonneville Unit of the Central Utah Project including a water collection system between Rock Creek and the Strawberry River, an enlarged Strawberry Reservoir and tunnel to convey water to the Bonneville Basin.

Item No. 7 of the U. S. B. R. covers the authorized Upalco Unit of the Central Utah Project affecting the Lake Fork River system in particular.

Item No. 8 of the U. S. B. R. covers the proposed Uintah Unit of the Central Utah Project affecting the Uintah River system in particular.
