

**RESTORATION
PROCLAMATION**

Beryl Area of the Escalante Desert in Iron and Washington Counties.

WHEREAS by a proclamation dated April 10, 1948, the Governor of the State of Utah, pursuant to Section 100-8-2, D.C.A., 1943, suspended the right to appropriate water from the following sources:

"That area bounded on the south and southwest by the water parting between the Great Basin and the Colorado River Drainage which said water parting follows the upper crest of the mountains north of Pine Valley, Santa Clara and Beaver Dam Valley, bounded on the west by a saddle in the neighborhood of the town of Modena and the water parting of the extension of the Wahwan Mountains; bounded on the east by the water parting between Cedar City Valley and the Escalante Desert and which crosses the Beaver River at the Minesville Dam, and bounded on the North by the township line between Township 30 South and Township 31 South."

WHEREAS, a portion of the above described area was restored to appropriation by proclamation dated January 25, 1953, and

WHEREAS, the State Engineer of the State of Utah has, since the date of the withdrawal, completed the proposed determination of water rights in the Escalante Valley which reveals that based upon the present supply and existing rights there appears to be no unappropriated water in this source with the exception of certain isolated areas and this basin can best be administered by the State Engineer without the existing withdrawal
