

of general circulation within the boundaries of the above named water sources; provided, that after the first publication of notice as aforesaid, applications may be deposited with the State Engineer and at the time such proclamation becomes effective the State Engineer shall hold public hearings, giving all applicants notice, to determine which applications so filed during the period of publication of such notice are most conducive to the public good, and shall file such applications in the order of priority according to such determination.
