Notice is hereby given of the following Restoration Proclamation of the drainage area of the Weber River and its tributaries and the drainage area of named streams in Box Elder and Davis Counties. The official publication of this Restoration Proclamation is found in the following issues of the Deseret News, Salt Lake City, Utah, October 7, 14, 21, 1955.

RESTORATION PROCLAMATION OF DRAINAGE AREA OF WEBER RIVER AND TRIBUTARIES AND DRAINAGE AREA OF NAMED STREAMS IN BOX ELDER AND DAVIS COUNTIES

Whereas, the State Engineer has recommended that the right of appropriation be restored.

Now, I, J. Bracken Lee, Governor of the State of Utah, upon the recommendation of the State Engineer, do hereby proclaim that the surplus and unappropriated water of the Weber River and its tributaries and of certain named streams in Box Elder and Davis Counties is being used for irrigation and other agricultural purposes;

This proclamation shall not become effective until notice thereof has been published at least once a week for three successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the boundaries of the above named water sources; provided, that after the first publication of notice as aforesaid, applications may be deposited with the State Engineer and at the time such proclamation becomes effective the State Engineer shall hold public hearings, giving all applicants notice, to determine which applications so filed during the period of publication of such notice are most conducive to the public good, and shall file such applications in the order of priority according to such determination.
