Valley and along the Bear River in Utah above Bear  
Lake and including the Bear River Drainage.

Due to the fact that there will be no Board meeting for several weeks, after conferring with O. A. Christensen of Box Elder County and L. B. Johnson of Rich County, it was deemed advisable to convey to you the action of the Board Committee. I feel sure that the other members of the Board would concur.

If it is your final decision to recommend restoration of both surface and subsurface waters and your recommendation is approved by the Governor, this Board would appreciate notice of your final decision so that it or the United States Bureau of Reclamation may file such applications as deemed necessary to protect the interests of the public in the full development of the Bear River System in Utah.
