Gentlemen:

RE: RESTORATION PROCLAMATION - BEAR RIVER

By Restoration Proclamation, J. Bracken Lee, Governor of the State of Utah, did restore to the public the right to appropriate the surplus and unappropriated water, for any and all lawful purposes, within the drainage area of the Bear River and all its tributaries and sources, both surface and underground in Summit, Rich, Cache and Box Elder Counties in Utah.

Said Restoration Proclamation was officially published in the Deseret News, Salt Lake City, Utah, October 7, 14 and 21, 1955. During the period of publication a certain number of applications to appropriate water were deposited in the office of the State Engineer.

Section 73-6-2, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, Laws of Utah, is quoted in part as follows:

"***** Applications for appropriations shall not be filed during the time such waters are withdrawn from appropriation; provided, that after the first publication of notice aforesaid applications may be deposited with the state engineer and at the time such proclamation becomes effective the engineer shall hold public hearings, giving all applicants notice, to determine which applications so filed during the period of publication of such notice are most conducive to the public good, and shall file such applications in order of priority according to such determination."

This is to notify you that a public hearing will be held in the office of the State Engineer, 403 State Capitol, Salt Lake City, Utah, at 10:00 a.m. November 18, 1955 to consider the priority of applications so deposited during the period of publication of such notice.
