RE: RESTORATION PROCLAMATION - BEAR RIVER

Minutes of meeting held in the office of the State Engineer, 403 State Capitol Building, Salt Lake City, Utah, November 18, 1955, L. C. Monson, Chief Deputy State Engineer, presiding.

Pursuant to the Restoration Proclamation of Hon. J. Bracken Lee, Governor of Utah, officially published in the Deseret News, October 7, 14 and 21, 1955 restoring to the public the right to appropriate the surplus and unappropriated water for any and all lawful purposes within the drainage area of the Bear River and all its tributaries and sources, both surface and underground, in Summit, Rich, Cache and Box Elder counties in Utah, and in accordance with notice of the State Engineer in letter dated October 28, 1955 to all applicants who deposited applications to appropriate water between October 7, 1955 and October 21, 1955, both dates inclusive, a public hearing was held in the office of the State Engineer, 403 State Capitol Building, Salt Lake City, Utah, at the hour of 10:00 a.m. to consider the priority of applications so deposited.
