PROCLAMATION

By the Governor of the State of
Utah

WHEREAS, in order to preserve
the surplus and unappropriated
water of the Logan River, a tri-
butary of Bear River, for use by
irrigation districts and organized
agricultural water users and for
other uses, the right of appro-
priation of water from such source
was heretofore suspended by Pro-
clamation of the Governor of
Utah pursuant to Section 100-8-1,
Utah Code Annotated, 1943, and

WHEREAS, there is no need for
further suspension of the right of
appropriation of the water of
Logan River and the State En-
gineer has recommended that the
right of appropriation be restored.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Heber
Bennion, Jr., Acting Governor of
the State of Utah, upon the recom-
mendation of the State Engineer
and pursuant to and by virtue of
the authority vested in the Gover-
nor of the State of Utah by Sec-
tion 100-8-2, Utah Code Annotated,
1943, hereby restore to appropria-
tion for any and all lawful pur-
poses the surplus and unappropri-
ated water of the Logan River and
all tributaries thereto. The procla-
mation withdrawing from appro-
priation the water of such source
is hereby revoked and annulled.

This proclamation shall not be-
come effective until notice there-
of has been published at least
once a week for three successive
weeks in a newspaper of general
circulation within the boundaries
of the Logan River system as pro-
vided by law.
