

W I T H D R A W A L   P R O C L A M A T I O N

February 2, 1949

Weber River, Ogden River, the following creeks in Davis County, North Canyon, Mill, Barton (Holbrook), Stone (Ward), Duell, Parris, Barnard, Rickss (Ford), Davis, Steed, North Cottonwood (Farmington), Shepherd, Hights (Bears), Webb, Adams, Snow, South Kays, Middle Kays, North Kays, and the following creeks in Box Elder County, Willard, Perry, Box Elder.

Provided, however, there is excepted from the effect of this proclamation (1) applications for appropriation of not exceeding two second feet of water for any one project from isolated water holes and springs, and underground sources in the drainage area of the streams named above; (2) applications for appropriation of not more than one second foot of water salvaged by elimination of channel and canal losses for any one project; (3) applications for change of point of diversion, place and nature of use which involve perfected water rights, and (4) application for exchange.
