At approximately 4:45 p.m. today, I signed and filed with the Secretary of State a proclamation designed to preserve the unappropriated and surplus water of the Bear River system and various tributaries to the Green River system within the State of Utah. This action is pursuant to authority vested in the Governor by Section 100-8-1, Revised Statutes of Utah, 1933, as amended by Chapter 130, Laws of Utah, 1937, and in accordance with the recommendation for withdrawal of unappropriated water submitted by you to the Governor this date.
