It will be noted that the foregoing Proclamation withdraws the water for an indefinite period and it will not be restored to appropriation until a Proclamation in accordance with Section 100-8-2 is made by the Governor.

Green River

Tributaries of the Green River in Summit and Daggett Counties, Utah, are withdrawn by the Proclamation quoted above. They are still withdrawn.

The foregoing is the only Proclamation withdrawing waters of the State of Utah from appropriation which is now in force and effect.

Fish Creek - Tributary of Price River, Oct. 27, 1921 to Sept. 11, 1924.

Jordan River August 26, 1921 to November 20, 1923;

November 24, 1923 to November 6, 1928.

The waters of Logan River flowing between Ricks Spring and the back water of the Logan City Power Plant were withdrawn from appropriation for purpose of developing power by special statutory provision, Compiled Laws, 1917, Sec. 3570. (Effective May 8, 1917) Repealed, Laws of Utah, 1935, Chapter 104, Sec. 4.

Price River - October 10, 1921 to October 27, 1921.

Provo River - August 26, 1919 to August 26, 1920;
August 14, 1920 to August 14, 1921;
August 26, 1921 to August 26, 1926;
August 25, 1924 to August 25, 1929.

Spanish Fork River - December 29, 1924 to December 24, 1929.

Utah Lake - Tributaries below mouth of Provo River and south thereof -
December 29, 1924 - December 29, 1929.

All of Utah Lake - August 26, 1921 to August 26, 1926;
August 25, 1924 to August 25, 1929.

Weber River - August 14, 1920 to August 14, 1921;
August 26, 1921 to August 26, 1926;
August 25, 1924 to August 12, 1929.
