

BARNSON SPRINGS

To Piute Reservoir & Irrigation Company, three-fourths of the flow of Barnson Springs, said three-fourths interest being fixed as 12 c.f.s. from January 1st to December 31st, said water not to be prorated with other users (except under the conditions herein specifically provided in connection with the 22 second feet awarded primary users in lieu of the make of the river between the two Kingston gauging stations and the gauging station known as "Sevier River below the Piute Dam", as now located below the dam of the Piute Reservoir), to be used for culinary, stockwatering and irrigation purposes, and to be diverted from the Barnson Springs located in the northwest quarter of Section 16, Township 29 South of Range 3 West, and stored in the Piute Reservoir and to be released therefrom and diverted from the Sevier River at the points and for use upon the lands as hereinafter described in connection with the storage filings, of said company, provided that any water stored under this right and used for culinary, domestic and stockwatering purposes shall be charged against the waters so stored.
