- Ira W. Hatch: To be diverted from Henrie Slough. Period of use: March 15th to November 15th. 1.00
- James H. Yardley: To be diverted out of the waters of Assay Springs (Garfield County), sufficient thereof to irrigate not to exceed 12 acres of meadows on the east side of Asay Creek.
- Also out of Jerome Asay Springs (Garfield County), to be used 5 successive days, out of each 14 days; provided that if the flow thereof receded to less than one second feet, then the entire flow thereof continuously; said waters to be used on lands under what is known as the "Jerome Asay Ditch". 2.00
- Blanche Showalter, M. C. Swapp, James A. Little and John Yardley: All the waters of Castle and Minnie or Little Creek, and out of spring areas tributary to said creeks, during the entire year.
- James A. Little: All the waters of that spring area rising near the west center quarter corner of Sec. 25, T. 37 S. R. 6 W., for use during the entire year. Also all the waters of two small springs rising in the south half of said section during the entire year.
- Hatch Town Corporation: To be diverted out of Mammoth Creek during the entire year. .50
- George Dodds: All the waters of Don's Spring and Pole Canyon Creek for use during the entire year.
- W. R. Riggs: All the waters of Burrows Wash, for use during the entire year.
- Mrs. Tenia Marshall: All the waters of Hatch Springs, for use during the entire year.
- Hettie L. Henrie: To be diverted from Proctor Canyon Creek, for use during the entire year. 1.00
- William Proctor, George Proctor, J. Proctor, Ken Proctor and M. J. Proctor: To be diverted from Proctor Canyon Creek, as a second-class right, as to the said right of Hettie L. Henrie, for use during the entire year. .75
- All of the remainder of the waters of Proctor Canyon Creek, to be divided, one-half thereof to Hettie L. Henrie and one-half thereof to William Proctor, George Proctor, J. Proctor, Ken Proctor and M. J. Proctor, for use during the entire year.
