William Proctor, George Proctor, J. Proctor, Ken Proctor, and M. J. Proctor: All the waters of an unnamed spring, located at a point about 1550 feet south and 2440 feet west of the northwest corner of Sec. 22, T. 36 S. R. 5 W., for use during the entire year.

State of Utah: All the waters of an unnamed spring located at a point about 950 feet north and 3260 feet east of the northwest corner of Sec. 25, T. 36 S. R. 5 W., during the entire year.

Joseph C. Clark: All the waters of Clark Springs during the entire year.

Rebecca Wilson and J. S. Wilson (common users): All the waters of Hillsdale Canyon Creek. To be diverted at a point about 1050 feet north and 3500 feet east of the southwest corner of Sec. 12, T. 36 S. R. 5 W., during the entire year.

J. E. Evans: To be diverted from Rock Canyon Creek. Period of use: March 15th to November 15th.
