

Mrs. Lora V. Gleave: All the waters of Gleave Spring, located at a point about 3450 feet north and 800 feet west of the south quarter corner of Sec. 11, T. 32 S., R. 2 W., for use during the entire year.

Charles Wiley: All the waters of Pine Creek for use during the entire year.

Daniel Day: To be diverted out of Poison Creek; and in addition thereto all excess waters thereof over one second foot when such excess is not sufficient to reach the East Fork of the Sevier River; and together with all the waters of Sheep Creek for use during the entire year. 1.00

Robert F. Hall: All the waters of Clear or Clark Spring, for use during the entire year.

Also all the waters of Forest Creek until the flow thereof shall exceed one-half of one cubic foot per second, for use during the entire year.

Charles E. Rowan, Sr.: All the waters of Pole Creek until the flow thereof shall exceed one-third of one cubic foot per second, for use during the entire year.

A. M. Hunter: All the waters of Hunter Spring for use during the entire year; and also all the waters of an unnamed spring located at a point about 1625 feet south and 490 feet east of the northeast corner of Sec. 4, T. 31 S. R. 2 W., for use during the entire year.

OTTER CREEK AND ITS TRIBUTARIES SEVIER AND PIUTE COUNTIES SOUTH FORK OF LITTLE LOST CREEK.

Mrs. Maud S. Mumford: All the waters thereof, to be diverted at a point of diversion as now located in the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Sec. 22, T. 24 S. R. 1 E., for use during the entire year.

Also all the waters of the North Fork of Booby Hole Creek, which may come to the present point of intersection and commingling of the waters diverted from Lost Creek into the North Fork of Booby Hole Creek, for use from November 1st to April 10th.

Also all the waters of Little Lost Creek as diverted at a point near the center quarter corner of the southwest quarter of Sec. 16, T. 24 S. R. 1 E., for use from June 20th to June 27th, and from October 1st to March 31st.
