W. E. Nielson, Mrs. Joseph Howes and Morris Howes as a primary right and to be diverted out of Dry Creek at the headgate of the Nielson Canal or such lesser amount of the waters thereof as will reach the headgate of said canal for use during the entire year.

Of this distribution the said W. E. Nielson is to have 7/17ths thereof, Mrs. Joseph Howes 5/17ths thereof, and Morris Howes 5/17ths thereof.

J. L. Sevy, Sr., and John L. Sevy, Jr., after the said rights of W. E. Nielson, Mrs. Joseph Howes and Morris Howes shall have been satisfied, the remainder of the waters of said Dry Creek, and also all of the waters of Tibadeau Creek, for use during the entire year.

Sevier Valley Canal Company: To be diverted out of Taylor Fish Pond, located in the south half of the South Half of Sec. 17; and the North Half of the North Half of Sec. 20, all in T. 27 S., R. 3 W., all of the waters thereof, not to exceed an average of four second feet of the flow thereof, with period of use from April 1st to November 25th.

Sevier Valley Roller Mills Company: All the waters decreed herein to the Annabella Irrigation Company and the Vermillion Irrigation Company through the millrace of the said Sevier Valley Roller Mills Company in Sevier County, for power purposes only, during the whole of each and every year; and from the 1st day of November to the 31st day of March of each year the said Mills Company is entitled to use for said purposes sufficient water, in addition to the waters decreed to said Annabella and Vermillion Companies, to make in the aggregate 32. second feet as against all parties to this action, except the Monroe South Bend Canal Company, and as against that company from the 1st day of November to the 15th day of March
