TO SANPETE OAK CREEK IRRIGATION CO., Fairview, Utah.
IRRIGATION:

(a) 24.50 c.f.s.; 10.70 c.f.s.; Priority: 1883; Period of Use: Apr. 1 to Oct. 15; Point of Diversion: To be diverted from Oak Creek at each, either or all of the following described points:

(1) 150 ft. S. and 1450 ft. E. of the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Sec. 24, T. 13 S., R. 4 E., into the North Canal.

(2) 150 ft. S. and 1450 ft. E. of the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Sec. 24, into the South Canal.
