

DOMESTIC AND STOCK WATER:

To Twin Creek Irrigation Company. 10 c.f.s.

From Twin Creek and from one-half of the flow of Cedar Creek; Period of Use: Oct. 15 to Apr. 1; Priority and Point of Diversion: Same as set out under First Class.

To Cedar Creek Irrigation Company 3 c.f.s.

To be supplied from one-half of the flow of Cedar Creek. Period of Use: Oct. 15 to Apr. 1; Priority and Point of Diversion: Same as set out under First Class as to Cedar Creek Irrigation Company.

Provided, that each prior right or class shall be supplied in full before any succeeding right or class shall be entitled to any water, and where there is not sufficient water to supply the rights in the same class in full, then such water belonging to such rights or class shall be pro rated between the parties according to their respective rights in such class.

Provided further, that as between the parties whose rights to the use of the waters of Twin and Cedar Creeks is decreed as hereinabove stated they shall have distributed to them the waters as hereinabove set out and according to the classes herein stated, irrespective of the date of priority stated.

4.00 c.f.s.; Priority 1878; Period of Use: All year use whenever the flow of the waters of Cedar Creek exceed 12.18 c.f.s. Said parties as successors in interest to Mads Nielson are entitled to divert, appropriate and use for irrigation of 133 acres of land embraced in Section 21, Township 15 South, Range 4 East, an amount not exceeding 4.00 c.f.s. of the excess of said waters above 12.18 c.f.s. to which primary appropriators are entitled.

Point of Diversion: From Cedar Creek at a point 1000 feet West and 700 feet North of the Southeast corner of Section 16. Township 15 South, Range 4 East into Mads Nielson Ditch.

The acreage and the rights to the use of said waters are owned as follows:

Said waters to be pro rated to the owners of the right as above set out in proportion as above shown. The said right of the said successors in interest of Mads Nielson is prior in time and right to all other claimants of the waters of said Cedar Creek, excepting the rights of successors in interest of primary appropriators to the extent of 12.18 c.f.s.
