Point of Diversion and Storage: From the Big Springs and stored in a reservoir the center of the impounding dam is at a point S. 86 degrees 00 minutes W. 3635 ft. from the NW corner of Sec. 1, T. 14 S., R. 2 E. and released and used in connection with the 13.00 c.f.s. described in paragraph (a) for generating electricity for power purposes and after being so used said water is to be returned to the City Ditch at a point 20 ft. DOMESTIC AND STOCK WATER:

0.02 c.f.s.; Priority: 1885; Period of Use: Jan. 1 to Dec. 31 incl.; Point of Diversion: From the Big Springs at a point 640 ft. E. and 1380 ft. N. of the SW corner Sec. 36, T. 13 S., R. 2 E. into a pipe line.

The said award is made subject to and said water shall be used in conformity with agreement between Fountain Green Irrigation Company and F. L. Hansen.

STIPULATION

"1. The Fountain Green Irrigation Company agree to allow Farrel Hansen 300 gallons of water per day to be drawn through the $\frac{3}{4}$ inch pipe installed and now used by him from the 20th of March to the 1st day of November of each and every year.

4. It is further agreed that Farrel Hansen will pay to the Fountain Green Irrigation Company for all water used in excess of the daily allowance of 300 gallons between March 20th and November 1st of every year at the rate of ten cents per 1000 gallons used.

5. It is further agreed by Farrel Hansen that his application as filed in the State Engineer's office at Salt Lake City for 0.02 c.f.s. of water, under Claim No. 578- $\frac{1}{2}$ on page 166 of the Proposed Determination of water rights on the Sevier River System, be cancelled and this agreement entered in lieu thereof."
