POWER:

(c) 7.53 c.f.s. Priority: July 8, 1911. Period of Use: Jan. 1 to Dec. 31. Point of Diversion: (1) From Cottonwood Creek at a point N. 11 degrees 55 minutes E. 1751 ft. from the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Sec. 13, T. 17 S., R. 3 E.;

(2) From New Canyon Creek at a point N. 28 degrees 23 minutes E. 4836 ft. from the last above described corner conveyed in two canals aggregating 15,885.7 ft. in length and a pipe line 1370 ft. long and used to generate power for electric lighting and propelling machinery in the City of Ephraim, and after being so used said water to be returned to the natural channel at a point which bears N. 78 degrees 07 minutes W. 6712 ft. from the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Sec. 13, T. 17 S., R. 3 E.

TO EPHRAIM IRRIGATION COMPANY, Ephraim, Utah.
IRRIGATION:

(a) 218.81 c.f.s. 95.73 c.f.s. Priority: 1854. Period of Use: March 15 to October 15. Points of Diversion: From Ephraim Cottonwood Creek at each, either or all of the following points:

(1) 3910 ft E. and 480 ft. S. of the NW corner Sec. 14, T. 17 S., R. 3 E. into an unnamed ditch.

(2) 3910 ft. E. and 450 ft. S. of the NW corner Sec. 14, T. 17 S., R. 3 E. into Ditch No. 17.

(3) 1595 ft. W. and 490 ft. N. of the SE corner Sec. 10, T. 17 S., R. 3 E. into an unnamed ditch.

(4) 2025 ft. E. and 2525 ft. N. of the SW corner Sec. 10, T. 17 S., R. 3 E. into the Gobble Field Ditch.

(5) 2000 ft. E. and 2540 ft. N. of the SW corner Sec. 10, T. 17 S., R. 3 E. into Ditches Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4.

(6) 1800 ft. E. of the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Sec. 10, T. 17 S., R. 3 E. into an unnamed ditch.

(7) 1255 ft. E. and 1660 ft. S. of the NW corner Sec. 10, T. 17 S., R. 3 E. into an unnamed ditch.

(8) 950 ft. E. and 1550 ft. S. of the NW corner Sec. 10, T. 17 S., R. 3 E. into an unnamed ditch.
