DOMESTIC AND STOCK WATER:

(b) 10 c.f.s. Priority: 1896. Period of Use: October 15 to April 1. Points of Diversion: Same as described in paragraph (a).
IRRIGATION:

(c) 68 c.f.s. Priority: February 28, 1913, Application No. 1335, Certificate No. 293. Period of Use: April 1 to July 1. Points of Diversion: (1) Sanpitch River at a point S. 69 degrees 17 minutes W. 541 feet from the NE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 32, T. 16 S., R. 2 E. into the Highland No. Canal.

(2) Twelve Mile Creek at a point S. 46 degrees 48 minutes W. 750 feet from the NE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 32, T. 18 S., R. 2 E. into the Highland No. Canal. **It is provided**, however, that all of the rights of the Highland Canal Company to the use of the water from Sanpitch River and its tributaries, Six Mile Creek and Twelve Mile Creek are subject to the right of the Gunnison-Fayette Canal Company to 25 c.f.s. out of 40 c.f.s. awarded to said Gunnison-Fayette Canal Company.

(d) Willow Creek. 12 c.f.s. Priority: May 5, 1913. Application No. 1537, Certificate No. 188. Period of Use: Apr. 1 to June 30. Point of Diversion: Willow Creek at a point N. 58 deg. 54 minutes E. 2640 feet from the SW corner Sec. 27, T. 20 S., R. 1 E., into the Highland No. Canal.

STORAGE AND IRRIGATION:

(e) 3535 ac. ft. Priority: 1896. Period of Use: June 1 to October 15. Period of Storage: October 15 to June 1. To be stored in the Highland Canal Company's Reservoir on Nine Mile Creek in Sanpete County, and to be released therefrom and used as a supplemental supply to irrigate lands under diversions mentioned in paragraph (a). Said right to divert and store water from Six Mile Creek in said reservoir is subject to the limitations hereinbefore set out.

IRRIGATION:

(a) 42.50 c.f.s. From one-fourth of the yield of Six Mile Creek. Priority: 1880. Period of Use: April 1 to October 15. Point of Diversion: To be diverted from Six Mile Creek at each, either or both of the following described points:

(1) In the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 35, T. 18 S., R. 2 E. into the Six Mile Ditch.

(2) At the above described point into the Funk's Lake Ditch.
