

Stephenson, James J. 80.1 acres, 40.4 acres in Section 16, Township 18 South, Range 4 West;
39.7 acres in Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 4 West.

Total135.4 acres.

Said water to be prorated to the owners of the right to the use thereof for periods of time in proportion as their respective acreage bears to the whole acreage.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Simeon T. Stephenson, Joseph A. Stephenson, John B. Stephenson, and Benjamin J. Shephenson are entitled to the use of 3 c.f.s. of the waters of Giles, Whiskey and Duggins Creek from January 1 to December 31 in each and every year, with priority date as of March 13, 1912, under certificate of appropriation issued by the State Engineer of the State of Utah, No. 1289. Said water to be diverted as follows: 2.00 c.f.s. from Giles Creek at a point North 11260 feet and East 257 feet from the Northeast corner of Section 16, Township 18 South, Range 4 West; .50 c.f.s. from Whiskey Creek at a point North 6190 feet and West 262 feet from said corner; .50 c.f.s. from Duggins Creek at a point 1310 feet West and 835 feet South of the above described corner. The waters from Giles and Whiskey Creek is conveyed through two canals and commingled. The commingled water is then conveyed a further distance and commingled with the waters of Duggins Creek. The water is used to irrigate 160 acres of land described as follows: 40 acres in Sec. 19, 40 acres in Sec. 30, both in Township 18 South, Range 4 West, and 80 acres in Section 25, Township 18 South, Range 5 West.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Simeon Stephenson is entitled to the use of 5.24 c.f.s. of the waters of Platinum Spring from January 1 to December 31 in each and every year, with priority date as of July 26, 1912, under certificate of appropriation issued by the State Engineer of the State of Utah, No. 791. The water is diverted from the Platinum Spring at a point 1551 feet South and 924 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 20, Township 18 South, Range 4 West, into a pipe line; conveyed to and discharged into Whiskey Creek, allowed to flow down Whiskey Creek to a point 650 feet South and 1115 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 25, Township 18 South, Range 5 West, at which point it is rediverted into an unnamed ditch and used to irrigate 11.27 acres of land in Section 25, Township 18 South, Range 5 West.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Eight Mile Creek Irrigation Company is entitled to the use of 11.93 c.f.s. of the waters of Eight Mile Creek from March 1 to June 1, with priority date as of 1880. Said water to be diverted from Eight Mile Creek at a point 1485 feet West and 2410 feet South of the Northeast corner of Section 24, Township 19 South, Range 4 West, into an unnamed ditch and used to irrigate 417.7 acres of land described as follows: 5.8 acres in Section 23,
