

Austin G. Ashby owns one-half; William T. Stevens one-fourth and Edward F. Stevens one-fourth of the entire flow of Church Springs. Also a domestic and stock watering right of the entire flow of said Church Spring from October 15 to April 1 next succeeding, with priority date as of 1860. Said water to be diverted from Church Spring as above described and used for domestic purposes of 30 persons and for stock watering purposes of 40 head of cattle, 30 horses, 20 cows and 100 sheep.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Holden Irrigation Company, Inc., is entitled to the use of 32.22 c.f.s. of the waters of Pioneer and Wild Goose Creeks, with priority date as of 1858. Said water to be diverted from (1) Pioneer Creek at a point in Sec. 52, Township 20 South, Range 3 West, into the Pioneer Ditch and (2) Wild Goose Creek at a point 60 feet East and 900 feet North of the Southwest corner of Section 29, Township 19 South, Range 3 West, into the Wild Goose Ditch and used to irrigate 1283.9 acres of land described as follows: 33.5 acres in Section 34, Township 34 South, Range 4 West; 268.7 acres in Section 2, 537.1 acres in Section 3, 119.0 acres in Section 4, 28.8 acres in Section 8, 13.7 acres in Section 9, 120.9 acres in Section 10, 137.9 acres in Section 11, 24.3 acres in Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 4 West. Also 3 c.f.s. of the waters of said Pioneer and Wild Goose Creeks during the non-irrigation season for stock watering purposes, with priority date as of 1858. Said water to be diverted as above described and used for stock watering purposes of 1500 head of horses and cattle. Also a supplementary right from Sundry Springs, with priority date as of 1858. Said water to be diverted from each, either, or all of the following: (1) from Big Spring at a point in the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 18, Township 20 South, Range 3 West; (2) from Current Spring at a point in the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 4 West; (3) from Oak Spring at a point in the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 11, Township 20 South, Range 4 West; (4) from Ebbs Spring a quarter of a mile North of Wild Goose Creek; (5) from Bullberry Spring at a point in the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 11, Township 20 South, Range 4 West; (6) from Savage Spring at a point in the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 1, Township 20 South, Range 4 West; (7) from an unnamed spring in the East half of Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 4 West, all into unnamed ditches and used as a supplemental supply to irrigate the land above described.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that William Paul or his successor or successors in interest, is entitled to the use of .05 c.f.s. of the waters of Oak or Adobe Spring, with priority date as of 1870. Said water to be diverted from the Oak or Adobe Spring at a point 305 feet West and 1645 feet South of the Northeast corner of Section 11, Township 20 South, Range 4 West, into an unnamed ditch and used to irrigate
