

That this court shall have jurisdiction to make all necessary supplemental orders which may be required to make effectual the rights herein decreed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Almon Robison estate and successors in interest to the same, are entitled to the use of 29 c.f.s. of the waters of Pine Creek, with priority date as of 1855. Said water to be diverted from Pine Creek at a point approximately in Section 28, Township 22 South, Range 4 West, into an unnamed ditch and used as a supplemental supply to Chalk Creek rights to irrigate 2319.1 acres of land described as follows: 51.0 acres in Section 27, 31.5 acres in Section 26, 169.9 acres in Section 33, 538.3 acres in Section 34, 613.4 acres in Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 5 West; 505.4 acres in Section 4, 53.1 acres in Section 5, 355.1 acres in Section 3, 1.4 acres in Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 5 West.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the estate of Almon D. Robison, and his successors in interest to the same, are entitled to 1.25 c.f.s. of the waters of said Pine Creek from July 15 to October 31 in each and every year, with priority date as of December 14, 1909, under certificate of appropriation issued by the State Engineer of the State of Utah, No. 1069. Said water to be diverted from Pine Creek at a point 780 feet West and 756 feet North of the South quarter corner of Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 4 West, into an unnamed ditch and used to irrigate 21.4 acres of land embraced in Section 29, Township 21 South, Range 4 West.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Harrison Anderson is entitled to the use of .60 c.f.s. of the waters of Maple Hollow, with priority date as of 1860. Said water to be diverted from Maple Hollow at a point North 62 degrees 52 minutes West 2412 feet from the East quarter corner of Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 4 West, into an unnamed ditch and used to irrigate 37.8 acres of land embraced in Section 29, Township 21 South, Range 4 West. Also a right to the use of .20 c.f.s. of the waters of said Maple Hollow during the non-irrigation season, with priority date as of 1860, for stock watering purposes. Said water to be diverted as above described and used for stock watering purposes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Nolan F. Robison is entitled to the use of .60 c.f.s. of the waters of Maple Hollow, with priority date as of 1860. Said water to be diverted from Maple Hollow at a point North 62 degrees 52 minutes West 2412 feet from the East quarter corner of Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 4 West, into an unnamed ditch and used to irrigate 40.9 acres of land embraced in Section 29, Township 21 South, Range 4 West.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Frank Warner is entitled to the use of .397 c.f.s. of the water of Triangle Canyon Creek from March 1 to June 30, with priority
