To the Users of Water from the Weber River System.

Gentlemen:

Herewith please find "Determination of Water Rights" on the Weber River System as prepared by the State Engineer.

Following the statute, and in the course of events, this determination or this determination corrected and amended will be transmuted into a final decree by the district court after hearing the water users.

If errors are found in this determination as now submitted, I will appreciate having them called to my attention so that corrections or necessary amendments may be recommended by me to the court to avoid if possible a faulty decree. I will cheerfully give any advice or help that I can in any matter pertaining to this determination upon request. This offer is made believing that the users may avoid the necessity of employing much, if any, technical assistance and thus reduce expense to a minimum.

Anticipating that much interest will be taken by the users in the "duty" of water, your attention is called to the subdivision "Duty of Water" and especially to the last sentence thereof.

In making this determination I have sought and received the cooperation of the board of directors of the Weber River Water Users Association. Members of this board have authorized me to offer their services to Water Users in any adjustments that may be necessary and I commend the plan of submitting difficulties pertinent to this determination to any or all of these gentlemen at your convenience.
