

Alfred Kearn, Dewitt Johnson, Lower Meadowville Canal Company, C. H. Alley and Andrew Mattson have failed and refused, and do now fail and refuse, to install any measuring devices at their respective points of diversion or at all, contrary to the express terms and provisions of said decree.

That by reason of said failure and refusal of said defendants to install measuring and controlling devices it is impossible for plaintiff to determine with accuracy and without unreasonable expense and trouble whether or not the terms of said decree are being complied with by said defendants.

That plaintiffs have installed a measuring and controlling device recommended and approved by a competent engineer.

W H E R E F O R E, affiant prays that an order issue from this court requiring said defendants, and each of them, to appear before this court on Wednesday, the 17th day of June, 1936, at 10:00 o'clock, A. M., at the courthouse at Randolph, Utah, then and there to show cause, if any there be, why said defendants should not be found in contempt of court for failure to comply with the terms of said decree, and punished accordingly.
