In this matter the Utah State Engineer submitted to this Court his proposed determination of the water rights, surface and underground, in the Bear River Drainage Area in accordance with Chapter 4, Title 73, of the Utah Code Annotated. Said proposed determination was protested by the College Irrigation Company, the Spring Creek Cache Irrigation Company, and certain individual water users collectively referred to as Clear Creek Water Users by a Petition filed with this Court in June of 1979. The protest of College Irrigation Company, Spring Creek Cache Irrigation Company, and Clear Creek Water Users contested the allocation by the Utah State Engineer of 34 cfs. of water to Logan River & Blacksmith Fork Irrigation Company. A trial was held on the issue in the Hall of Justice in Logan, Cache County, Utah, on April 22,
