

I. JURISDICTION

This is an action to determine the rights to the use of all of the water, both surface and underground, within the drainage area of the Bear River and all of its tributaries in Utah. This action is filed pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 4, Title 73, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, and jurisdiction of the Court is not disputed and is hereby determined to be present.

II. SETTLED AND DISMISSED PROTESTS

A. Joseph E. Cowley: Pursuant to the stipulation of all interested parties, the Protest of Joseph E. Cowley is granted and the priority date for all water users involved therein is fixed at May 1, 1860. The Proposed Determination of Water Rights is amended to show a May 1, 1860, priority for the following Water User's Claims:

B. C. Dorris R. Roskelley: The Protest of Dorris R. Roskelley against Don T. Meikle is granted, since neither Mr. Meikle nor anyone representing him appeared in opposition to said Protest. The Proposed Determination of Water Rights is amended to delete Water User's Claim No. 25-6378, and said Claim is denied.

D. Clarence John Funk: The Protest of Clarence John Funk against Lee K. Blair is hereby dismissed without prejudice to the right of either party to file a separate action to resolve any disputes which they may have regarding their respective obli-
