The above entitled matter coming on regularly to be heard on the petition of the State Engineer of Utah praying for an interlocutory order affirming the proposed determination of water rights on Pleasant Creek and Sandy Creek subdivision, and proof being made that all water users listed in said Proposed Determination had received notice thereof, except the United States of America and the State of Utah, and that only one protest was filed thereto and that the protestants and the State Engineer have stipulated to a satisfactory settlement of that protest, and the court having heard and considered all relevant matters and the allegations of said petition having been found to be true and correct, now, therefore, upon motion of counsel for the State Engineer, it is

ORDERED:

1. That the claimants under Water Users Claims Nos. 7, 12, 17 and 18 are entitled to flow of water during the non-irrigation season sufficient to meet the water requirements for 6 families, which is 650 g.p.d. per family, at their place of use. This 650 g.p.d. is in addition to water needed for stockwatering purposes as provided in the Proposed Determination of Water Rights. The exact flow of water to be awarded at the point of diversion from Pleasant Creek during this period is to be determined by measurements at the points of diversion and use and will be the subject of a future report to the court. Water for the domestic requirements for these 6 families during the irrigation season is to be transported with and is considered a part of the irrigation award except for the amount actually consumed for domestic purposes at the place of use and for stockwatering purposes.
