

American Fork, Utah
December 5, 1899.

An agreement entered into this the 5th day of December,
A.D. 1899, between Lehi Irrigation Company, Pleasant Grove City
Corporation and American Fork City Corporation.

We hereby mutually and severally agree that the division of
the waters of American Fork Creek between the three parties afore-
said, shall be between the 20th day of September and the 15th day
of April following each and every year as follows, to-wit:

Lehi Irrigation Company to draw 5½ feet, Pleasant Grove City
Corporation to draw 2½ feet and American Fork City Corporation to
draw the balance of 25 feet. American Fork City Corporation fur-
ther agrees to supply the East Bench Ditch, formerly known as the
Heiselt Ditch, with water for culinary purposes during the period
aforesaid. Division of said water shall always be made at the mouth
of American Fork Canyon.
