Supplemental Decree

This cause coming on to be heard upon this 19th day of May, A. D. 1906, upon the question as to the quantity of water the defendants, the spring city Irr. Company, a corporation, James P. Mortenson, George Rylund, Andrew Nortensen, and Soren Peterson, should have on account of certain waters appropriated by them and conveyed to Cedar Creek and mingled with the waters thereof, the parties plaintiffs and defendants being present in open court as by their respective council and having agreed in open court as to the matters involved in the question and having consented in open court that this decree be ordered, and the court being now fully advised in the premises.

It is therefore ordered, and adjusted and decreed that a commissioner shall annually be appointed and agreed upon by and between the watermasters of the plaintiffs, the Twin Creek Irrigation Company and the corporation known as the ~~Cedar~~ cedar Creek Irrigation Company. Successor in interest to Spring City, plaintiff herein, and the defendants, Spring City Irrigation Company, James P. Mortensen, George Rylund, Andrew Mortensen, and Soren Peterson, or in case of their failure to agree among themselves then said commissioner to be appointed by this court. The duties of said commissioner shall be whenever requested at the beginning of the irrigation season to proceed to the point where said water has usually
