Burr in the sum of \$57.49; those of the issues between Daniel Hansen and W. H. Schock and others, against said Daniel Hansen in the sum of \$1,000.00; and those of the issue between C. C. Lee and the Monroe Irrigation Company and others, against said C. C. Lee in the sum of \$2,275.00.
