And running thence;--W. 35 ft. S. 881 ft., W. 2540 ft., S. 25°30' W. 156 ft., to a point 112 ft. S. of NW. cor. SW.¼ NE.¼ Sec. 30, through the land of the defendant, Gideon Curtis;

And running thence; -S. 25°30' W. 141 ft., S. 14°45' W. 300 ft., S. 8°45' E. 200 ft., S. 6°45' E. 200 ft., S. 4°15' E. 300 ft., S. 9°00' E. 100 ft., S. 1°45' W. 57 ft., to a point 30 ft. W. of cen. Sec. 30, through the land of the defendant, John B. Johns;

And running thence;--S. 1°45' W. 43 ft. S. 43°00' E. 46 ft., to a point 74 ft. S. of cen. Sec. 30, through the land of the defendant, Isaac M. Allen;

And running thence;--S. 43°00' E. 14 ft., South 1236 ft., to a point 10 ft. East of SW. cor. NW.¼ SE.¼ Sec. 30, Tp. 1 S. R. 1 E., through the land of the defendant, Warren Lock; which is the end of said Curtis Lateral.

Beginning at the head of the said Eskelson Lateral, which is a point 30 ft. S. of NW. cor. Sec. 9, Tp. aforesaid, and running thence East 1320 ft. to a point 30 ft. S. of NE. cor. NW.¼ NW.¼ said Sec. 9, through the land of the defendant, Yellow Stone;

And running thence;--East 1320 ft. to a point 30 ft. S. of N.¼ cor. of said Sec. 9, through the land of the defendant Glen Reed;

And running thence;--East 970 ft., S. 31°30' E. 700 ft., to a point 627 ft. S. of the NE. cor. said Section 9, through the land of the defendant, Thresa Reed; which is the end of said Eskelson Lateral.

Then beginning at the head of said Reynolds lateral, which is a point 30 ft. S. and 30 ft. W. from the E.¼ cor. of said Sec. 8, and running thence. W. 1290 ft. to a point 30 ft. South from NW. cor. NE.¼ SE.¼ Sec. 8 aforesaid, through the land of the defendant, Stella Chepoose, which is the end of the Reynolds lateral.

Then beginning at the head of said Allen Lateral, which is a point 30 ft. W. and 10 ft. S. from the NW. cor. SW.¼ NW.¼ Sec. 16, Tp. aforesaid, and running thence;--East 30 ft. to a point 10 ft. South of the aforesaid point, through the land of the defendant, Clyde Pike;

And running thence;--East 1320 ft. to a point 10 ft. South from NW. cor. SE.¼ NW.¼ Sec. 16 through the land of the defendant, Lawrence Pike; which is the end of said Allen Lateral.

6. That the easement and right of way through the said canal and laterals and over the lands above described is for a public use, namely, that of conveying water therethrough and thereover for irrigation and domestic purposes, and is the only practical or feasible way by means of which plaintiff may obtain water for the irrigation of said lands of its stockholders, and the condemnation of the lands over which said canals extend to a width on each side of the above described center line necessary for the enlargement of said canal and laterals to the extent hereinafter decreed, is authorized by law, as well as is the right to enlarge the said canal and laterals, and this is a proper case for the condemnation of said lands to the extent hereinafter decreed, and the establishment of the right on the part of the plaintiff to enlarge said canal and its laterals.

7. It is further, ordered, adjudged and decreed that a strip of land 40 feet wide, the center line of which is hereinbefore described as the center line of the Indian Bench Canal, is necessary for the plaintiff's use for the enlargement and use of said Indian Bench Canal, and the same is hereby condemned for said use to and for plaintiff and James R. Garfield, Secretary of the Interior of the United States,
