That in cases where the quantity of water determined of the various individuals or companies are too small for practical irrigation purposes, such rights may be combined wherever possible, and rotated among the various users both upon the stream and the various canals in such a way as to deliver to each user in the most effective manner the total quantity of water which he would receive if distribution were made on the basis of a continuous flow as outlined in the Schedule of Rights hereinafter set forth. Such combination of rights shall be made by the water commissioner distributing the water subject to the control of the State Engineer.

XI.

That the various parties to this suit having rights to the use of the waters from said Hill Creek are hereby decreed to have such rights as regards priority, acreage and the amount of water as are set forth in the Schedule of Rights on Hill Creek System which are as follows:
