

such length of time each day as will afford it sufficient water for said purposes when economically used;

The defendant, Pine Valley Irrigation Company, a Corporation, is the owner of and is entitled to use four-sevenths ( $4/7$ ) of the volume of the waters of said Santa Clara Creek where it runs through the said settlement known as and called Pine Valley;

The defendant, Partha Ann Hunt, is the owner of and is entitled to use one-seventh ( $1/7$ ) of the residue of the waters of said Santa Clara Creek for fifteen (15) hours during each week;

The defendant, Charles F. Foster, is the owner of and is entitled to use one-seventh ( $1/7$ ) of such residue of the waters of said Santa Clara Creek for nineteen (19) hours during each calendar week, to be taken and used subsequent to and after the said defendant, Partha Ann Hunt, shall have used the same for fifteen (15) hours;

The defendant, Henry Chadburn, is the owner of and is entitled to use one-seventh ( $1/7$ ) of such residue of the waters of said Santa Clara Creek for twelve (12) hours during each calendar week, the same to be taken and used subsequent to and after the said Charles F. Foster shall have used the same for nineteen (19) hours;

The defendant, Robert Chadburn, is the owner of and is entitled to use one-seventh ( $1/7$ ) of such residue of the waters of said Santa Clara Creek for five (5) hours during each calendar week, the same to be taken and used subsequent to and after the said Henry Chadburn shall have used the same for twelve (12) hours;

The defendant, Gunlock Irrigation Company, a Corporation, is the owner of and is entitled to use  $105/1430$  of the residue of the waters of said Santa Clara Creek;

The defendant, the United States of America, is the owner of and is entitled to use  $70/1430$  of such residue of the waters of said Santa Clara Creek;

The defendant, Santa Clara Field Canal Company, a Corporation, is the owner of and is entitled to use  $455/1430$  of such residue of the waters of said Santa Clara Creek;

The plaintiff, St. George-Clara Field Canal Company, a Corporation, is the owner of and entitled to use  $800/1430$  of such residue of the waters of said Santa Clara Creek.
