

The List of Unclaimed Rights of Record is on file with the Clerk of the Seventh Judicial District Court in and for Grand County located at 125 East Center Street, Moab, Utah. Additional copies may be obtained, upon payment of the cost of duplication, from the Division of Water Rights at 1594 West North Temple, Salt Lake City, Utah.

Any claimant who desires to object to the List of Unclaimed Rights of Record must file a written objection and a water user's claim with the Clerk of the Seventh Judicial District Court in and for Grand County (pursuant to Utah Code § 73-4-9.5). A water user's claim must also be concurrently filed with the State Engineer. Objections to the List of Unclaimed Rights of Record must be filed within **ninety (90) days** of the date of this notice.

In accordance with Utah Code § 73-4-9.5 and § 52-4-207, the State Engineer will be holding two public meetings to discuss the List of Unclaimed Rights and review the adjudication process. The first meeting will be held June 13, 2023 at 10:00 a.m in the Aneth Chapter House, located on SR 162 near Riverside Ct. in Aneth.
