# Navajo-Utah Water Right Settlement

## **Historical Timeline**

- Informal initial discussions
- Negotiations began in 2003
- Reserved right report published in 2004
- Agreement signed in 2015
- Federal Congressional approval in 2020
- State Legislative approval in 2021





## Initial Reserve Right Quantification Report

- Initial Practicably Irrigable Acres (PIA) Estimate
  - 152,000 acre-feet depletion for irrigation
  - Plus 14,800 acre-feet for domestic/municipal/industrial
- Divisions Concerns:
  - Unrealistic population growth rate
  - Unrealistic crop yields
  - Inclusion of non-irrigable lands
  - Unrealistic labor and power costs
  - Unequitable fraction of Utah's compact allocation



### Settlement Details, Part 1

- 435 cfs for San Juan River; 81,500 acre-feet of depletion
  - Block 1 69,275 acre-feet 1884 Priority
  - Block 2 4,480 acre-feet 1905 Priority
  - Block 3 3,670 acre-feet 1933 Priority
  - Block 4 4,075 acre-feet 1958 Priority
- Subordination:
  - No subordination for <u>existing</u> Navajo uses
  - Existing State-based rights protected from impairment by <u>new</u> Navajo uses.
- Compact Curtailment: curtailment by reservation priority date

### Settlement Details, Part 2

- Monitoring and Ongoing Notice
  - Any use depleting more than 100 acre-feet/year
- Water Development Project Funding
  - Federal: ~\$200 million
  - State: \$8 million
- No out of state use (unless part of neighboring state's allotment)
- Off reservation use requires approved change application

## What happening now?

- Signing Ceremony: May 27, 2022
- General Adjudication: Navajo Nation Subdivision 09-1
  - Summons: March 16, 2022
  - Notice to File Claims
    - General: May 4, 2022
    - Federal: July 28, 2022
- Proposed Determination Planned in 2024
- Federal Hydrographic Survey
  - Expected in 2024












### What is The List of Unclaimed Rights

- Identifies State Based Rights of Record that did not receive a Water Users Claim during the claim filing period
  - Recommends that rights are to be considered abandoned
  - 29 rights did not receive claims
  - 22 of these are associated with oil and gas companies
- The Reserve Right established by the 2022 Settlement Agreement is unaffected by the List of Unclaimed Rights





### Accessing the List of Unclaimed Rights

#### **Recipients of the Notice of the List of Unclaimed Rights:**

- Water Right owners listed on the records of the State Engineer
- Property owners within the Navajo Nation adjudication areas.
- Registered agents for corporate entities within the adjudication boundary.
- Counsel of record who have filed an appearance with the court






