Notice to Water Users and Interested Parties:

Recently completed research on the hydrogeology of Cedar Valley is now available to the public. Because of rapid growth in the basin and the accompanying demand for water, the State Engineer, in cooperation with the Utah Geological Survey (UGS), commissioned a study of the area.

A Utah Geological Survey geologic framework study entitled *The Geology of the Cedar Valley, Utah County, Utah, and its relation to Ground-Water Conditions* was published this year as UGS Special Study 109. It gives a geologic overview of Cedar Valley and the surrounding mountains.

Copies of the study are available for purchase through the DNR Bookstore, or may be viewed online at the UGS and Division of Water Rights websites, respectively.

The State Engineer has scheduled a public meeting to review the data presented in this study with water users. This meeting is scheduled for July 21, 2004 at 2:00 PM in the Council Chamber of the Eagle Mountain City Hall, 1680 East Heritage Drive, Eagle Mountain, Utah. Personnel from the Division of Water Rights and the UGS will make presentations.
