Subject: Comments on Water Policy for the Argyle Canyon area of the Nine-Mile Creek Drainage

Thank you for the invitation to meet at the public meeting on Nov 18 to discuss the water resources of Argyle Creek. We were unable to attend and would like to make the following comments:

1. The present holders of water rights should not waste water.
2. If the Argyle Creek flows through private property the property owner should be entitled to a reasonable amount of creek water for domestic use.
3. It is obvious that if more people keep building cabins in Argyle Canyon and the water is very scarce that the cabin owners will have to haul in their water. This is what they must do under present conditions.
4. All people need to conserve water and use good water-saving practices.
5. We suggest building water storage reservoirs in Argyle Canyon to provide water for future and present Canyon property owners.
