We, the members of the Iron County Farm Bureau, have some concerns with the proposals you have put forth to reach safe yield in a water management plan for the Beryl/Enterprise area and how you have in essence ignored the plan put forward by the water users.

In the law it says, "may" develop a water management plan. Our question is, who is pushing to develop this plan? On the other hand, the law says you "shall" take into account the economic impact of any plan on the communities of the area involved. You seem to be ignoring this part of the law.

In our last letter we asked that you slow down this process to gain better information, but you seem to pushing it as fast as possible, (such as two public hearings in the middle of the summer, our busiest season.)

We urge you to listen more to the local Water Users Plan. Take into account the long-term economic impact.
