This has severely impacted these irrigation companies. Not only these irrigation companies have been dried up, but also wells in the south west part of Utah County.


The Ensign-Bickford clean-up by pumping year around has also severely impacted these companies as well as the other wells and systems.

Cities in the southern end of Utah County have plenty of Strawberry water that they could put into secondary systems that would save their stream use for culinary water pulled out of wells.

There should be no more wells drilled in the southern end of Utah County.
