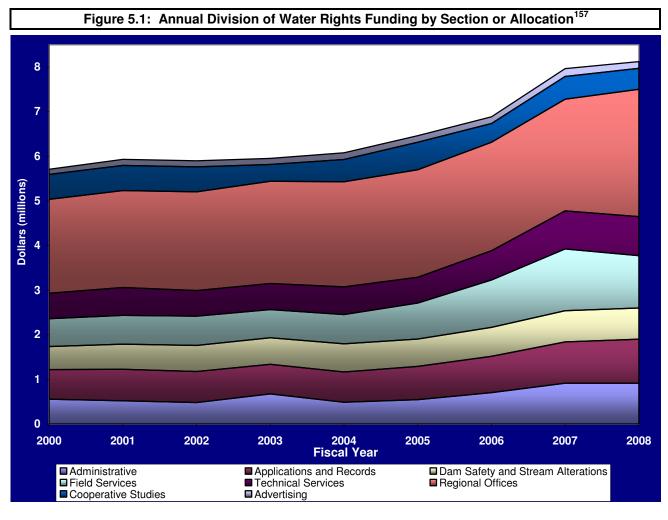
# Financial Reports 2002-2008 By Kevin Arthofer

Funds are appropriated annually by the State Legislature for the purpose of carrying out the duties and functions of the Division of Water Rights. In addition to legislature-appropriated funds, the Division receives Federal funding and records any dedicated credit. The appropriated funds for the Division have seen a steady rise from under six million in 2000 to over eight million in 2008. The funds for each section largely go to funding of full time permanent positions (Program B), at large employees (AL), and interning and other personnel. The rise in appropriated funds has not gone to the increase in total employees—As earlier noted, the Division has long been staffed by about 70 employees in total. The increases in appropriated funds has lead to the advancements in Division programs as outlined in this report and as evidenced by the Division Website and related publications. Moreover, according to Olds, deserved increases in salary for many Division positions were observed with his administration. Figure 5.1 below shows the Division funding by section or purpose:

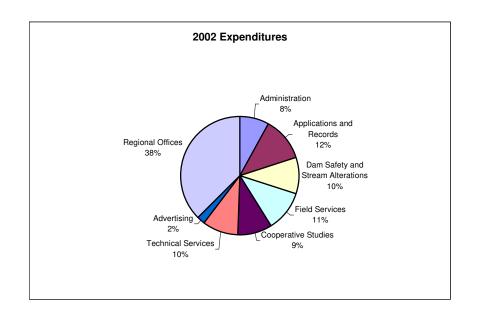

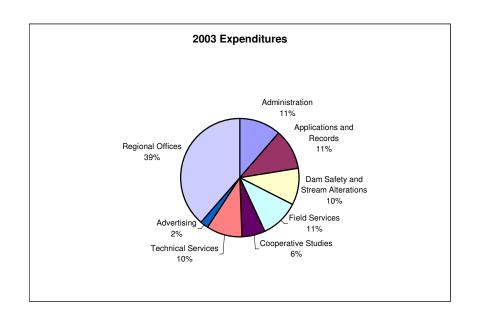
